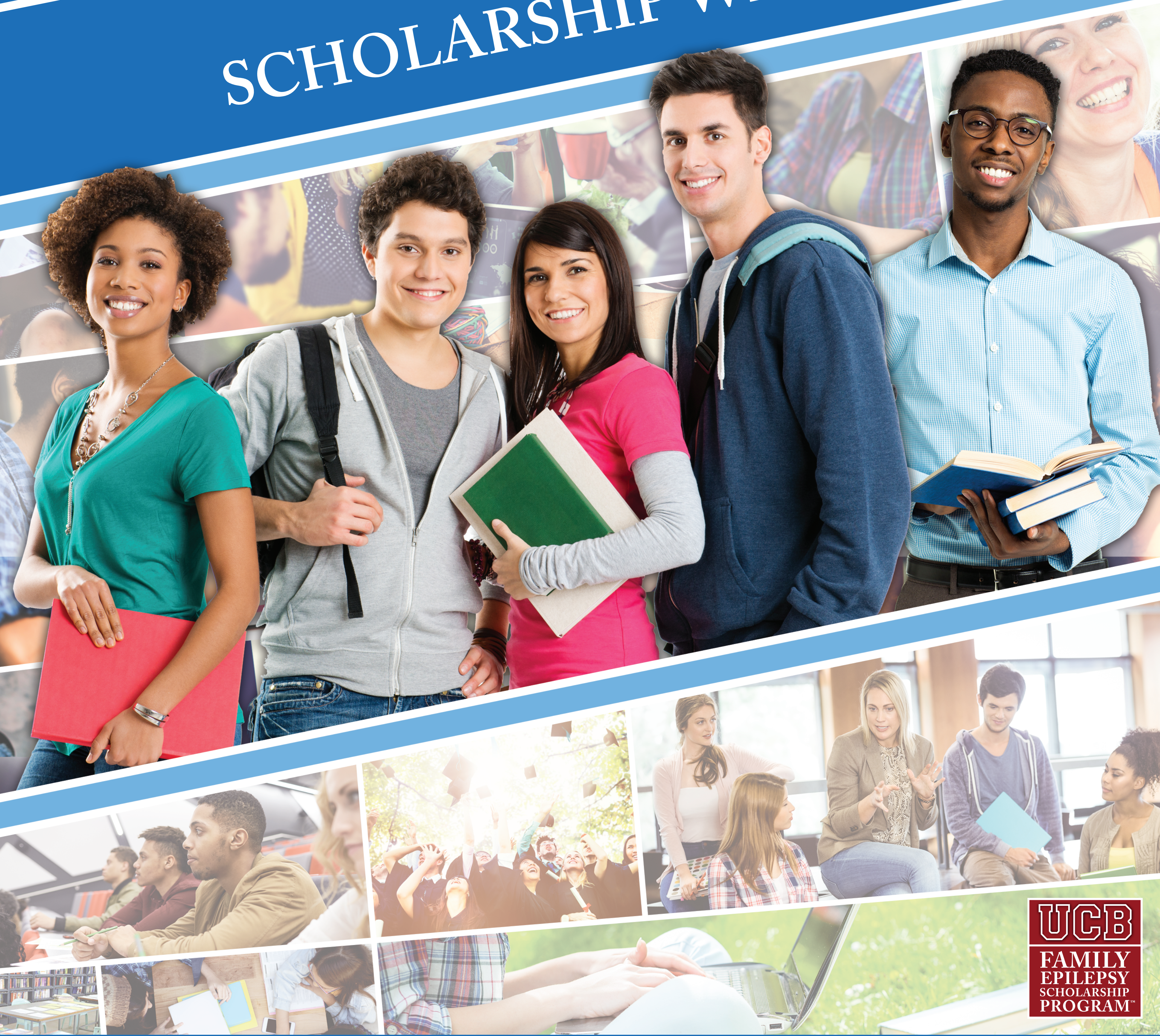

Winners of the \$10,000 Scholarship

In 2017, UCB awarded 32 scholarships totaling \$170,000 to a very deserving group of people living with epilepsy, family members and caregivers. Thirty winners were awarded scholarships of \$5,000. In addition to the 30 scholarships of \$5,000, UCB also awarded two recipients the Epilepsy Leader Scholarship in the amount of \$10,000 each.

The Epilepsy Leader Scholarships were founded in 2016 in honor of the late Sandra "Sandy" Helmers, MD, MPH and the late John M. "Jack" Pellock, MD, who passed away in 2016. This year's winners of the Epilepsy Leader Scholarships, Olivia D. and Kali L., were selected for exemplifying attributes that Drs. Helmers and Pellock were best known for including a desire to advocate for and serve others, an interest in positively contributing to the epilepsy community and a persevering spirit.
